

## Southern Rivers Cruise 2022

### Friday 12<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> August

Welcome to the itinerary for the SRC 2022!

As previously highlighted, the plan for this year will be a relaxed cruise heading to a number of the more popular overnight stops across the week, with pub options most nights for those looking for an easier week afloat. For this year, the route will give participants a choice of two mooring locations each night within the same area to choose from – this gives everyone a choice in case they have a more favoured mooring spot in the area that the cruise has stopped and would prefer that location, but still keeps them included within the cruise planning without feeling isolated from the rest of the fleet.

In addition, for any participants who may feel concerned about gathering in large groups in the current climate, it gives them a choice of two alternative locations to choose from whilst again keeping them included within the overall cruise for the week.

The route for 2022 is shown below – you can see each night there are two location choices (A & B) for you to choose where to moor, so you have the freedom and flexibility to make a decision for each night based on your own personal preference and your previous experiences down south.

Below the route, I have highlighted for each option if you are able to book moorings at the locations and the contact details for you to make your own mooring reservations. In addition, where possible I have recommended a pub as an option for dinner based on recent feedback from other EACC members, along with the contact details for you to book your own table at a time that suits you.

I would **strongly recommend** booking tables and moorings well in advance, as feedback from other EACC members is that venue space is limited and they are taking bookings well in advance, which is making last minute reservations difficult.

In addition, I am also planning a G&T gathering on Thursday evening at the Dutch Tea Gardens for those that would like to attend – I have a surplus of gin (plain and flavoured) which needs drinking so I will be donating this to the gathering, and in exchange for a small donation I will also provide the tonic, lemons and the ice, with any surplus monies being donated back to the club funds.
